New Grades 1-3

Following on from the successful launch of the new Pre-Primary in Dance and Primary in Dance syllabi in 2009, the Royal Academy of Dance is now introducing new syllabi for Grades 1-3.

The underlying philosophy of the new work is to provide students and teachers with a sequential syllabus that will promote a developmentally appropriate and sound technique for ballet. As with Pre-Primary in Dance and Primary in Dance, Grades 1-3 will promote 'feeling before form' and advocate the creation of learning environments that are open, dynamic and empowering. The focus will be on identifying the necessary skills that underpin secure technique, while continuing to nurture the students' awareness of artistry and dynamics. Musically inspired exercises and dances will motivate students to acquire a well rounded understanding of ballet and character and promote joy in movement, sense of dance and performance quality. The music for the syllabi is a glorious collection of three centuries of dance music, including recordings made exclusively for the RAD by the Orchestra of English National Ballet conducted by Gavin Sutherland.

Examination Information

The current Grades 1-3 syllabi will cease to be examined at the end of December 2012 and the new syllabi will be examined from January 2013. The new syllabi have fewer exercises than the current Grades, although the overall content is more comprehensive.

There will be three Assessment options – Grade Examinations, Class Awards and Solo Performance Awards. The third and new assessment - the Solo Performance Award - has been introduced so that students may work with their teachers to perform three solos, of which at least two must be chosen from the examination syllabi, while the third solo may be either chosen from the syllabi or created by the teacher.

Medals will be awarded in recognition of both Examinations and Class Awards and a bar which can be worn with the medal will be awarded for the Solo Performance Award.

All assessment options may use either live or recorded music, though all dances are performed to recorded music. As with Pre-Primary in Dance and Primary in Dance, teachers and students may choose between two musical selections provided for each exercise.

Grades 1–3 comprise the RAD's Graded provision at Level 1 of the Qualifications and Credit Framework. An examination **Specification** will be published and will detail the aims, content, learning outcomes, assessment criteria and guidance on the practical matters related to the syllabi. The *Specification* will be available in English, French, German, Greek, Italian, Japanese, Mandarin, Portuguese, and Spanish and will be available as a download from www.rad.org.uk or a printed document on request from December 2011.

The colours for the Grades 1-3 **Uniform** will be the same as for Pre-Primary in Dance and Primary in Dance with the addition of Lavender, Mulberry and Navy Blue ¹ from the current Grades uniform. You should check with your stockists regarding the availability of sleeveless or short-sleeved leotards in these colours.

Essential Course Information

This leaflet contains the dates and places where Grades 1-3 syllabi courses will be held in 2012. Teachers may attend courses anywhere in a country or throughout the world. Plan a holiday around a course. The only stipulation is that the course application must be made to the country or office of your choice.

Teachers will be able to choose from a number of venues and dates to enable them to receive advice on how to teach the new work in time to introduce it to their students and for them to take either an Examination, Class Award or Solo Performance Award at the first opportunity in 2013.

Teachers attending this course will obtain knowledge of the syllabi content and an understanding of the appropriate build-up required for success in the teaching of this new work. The course will also be beneficial to those teachers who are committed to further developing and broadening their teaching skills and dance knowledge.

The RAD recognises that some teachers may only teach an individual Grade, but as some of the concepts apply equally to all Grades, and the content of Grades 1–3 increases progressively, the course does not naturally lend itself to a day per Grade.

The course has therefore been specifically designed over three days and will be beneficial to:

- teachers currently teaching and entering students up to Grade 3
- students from the age of 16 who are training to be teachers
- teachers committed to furthering their teaching skills

It will cover:

- Aims of the syllabi
- Learning outcomes and assessment criteria
- Choreographic content
- Guidelines on how to further develop technique, artistry, musicality and creativity in students in relation to the syllabi content
- Teaching methods
- Advice on preparation and procedures for Grades 1-3 Examinations, Class Awards and Solo Performance Awards

Days: The course is three days long.

Hours: Each day will consist of three hours in the morning and three hours in the afternoon, with an hour for lunch. Exact start and finish times will vary from course to course, but are likely to be:

Start time: Between 9am – 10am

Finish time: Between 4pm – 5pm

Clothing: Comfortable clothes and shoes.

Resources: Participants should bring their own copy of the *Set exercises and Dances* for each level (refer to Resources and Sales Order form).

Course Notes: Participants will be able to download the Course Content – available in English, French, German, Greek, Italian, Japanese, Mandarin, Portuguese, and Spanish - from the Publications section of www.rad.org.uk from December 2011.

5. For courses which are offered during or after an examination session, the closing date is one month prior to the start of the course.
